

# Apr. 1, 2016 – Sivashankar Sivasubramaniam

**Defendant:** Sivashankar Sivasubramaniam, 39, of Kitchener.

**Charge:** Part III Provincial Offences Act summons for an offence under the *Ontario College of Trades and Apprenticeship Act, 2009*, sec. 2 – individual engaging in compulsory trade without a Certificate of Qualification.

**Summary:** On Sept. 16, 2015, Ontario College of Trades enforcement officers performed an inspection at a construction site in Gwillimbury, in response to a complaint that unauthorized individuals were performing compulsory work. Sivasubramaniam was confirmed to be performing work of a refrigeration and air conditioning systems mechanic (313A) while not having a Certificate of Qualification or being a member of the College.

On Apr. 1, 2016, Sivasubramaniam pleaded guilty to the charge under sec. 2 of the *Ontario College of Trades and Apprenticeship Act, 2009*.
