

Apr. 5, 2016 – Coffee Heating and Air Conditioning Inc.

Defendant: Coffee Heating and Air Conditioning Inc. – Newmarket

Charge: Part I Provincial Offences Act summons for an offence under the *Ontario College of Trades and Apprenticeship Act, 2009*, sec. 4 – employing or otherwise engaging individual to engage in compulsory trade without a Certificate of Qualification.

Summary: On Oct. 23, 2015, Ontario College of Trades enforcement officers followed up on a unit installation at a Wallaceburg residence. Two individuals were confirmed to be performing work of refrigeration and air conditioning systems mechanics (313A) while not having Certificates of Qualification or being members of the College.

On Apr. 5, 2016, Coffee Heating and Air Conditioning pleaded guilty to the charge under sec. 4 of the *Ontario College of Trades and Apprenticeship Act, 2009*.
