Defendant: Mohammed Khayrizadeh, 27, of Newmarket.

Charge: Part III Provincial Offences Act summons for an offence under the Ontario College of Trades and Apprenticeship Act, 2009, sec. 2 – individual engaging in compulsory trade without a Certificate of Qualification.

Summary: On Oct. 23, 2015, Ontario College of Trades enforcement officers followed up on a unit installation at a Wallaceburg residence. Two individual were confirmed to be performing work of refrigeration and air conditioning systems mechanics (313A) while not having a Certificate of Qualification or being members of the College.

On Apr. 5, 2016, Khayrizadeh pleaded guilty to the charge under sec. 2 of the Ontario College of Trades and Apprenticeship Act, 2009; suspended sentence.
