

# July 28, 2016 – Ontario Inc. o/a McKinnon Heating & Cooling

**Defendant:** Ontario Inc. o/a McKinnon Heating & Cooling

**Charge:** Part I *Provincial Offences Act* summons for an offence under the *Ontario College of Trades and Apprenticeship Act, 2009*, sec. 4 – employing or otherwise engaging individual to engage in compulsory trade without a Certificate of Qualification.

**Summary:** On March 31, 2016, Ontario College of Trades enforcement officers conducted an inspection at an Etobicoke residence. The enforcement officers determined that one individual was performing the work of a residential (low rise) sheet metal installer (308R) without proper qualifications, in particular, the individual did not hold a Certificate of Qualification and was not apprentice in the trade working pursuant to a registered training agreement.

On July 28, 2016, Ontario Inc. o/a McKinnon Heating & Cooling was convicted of the charge and the court imposed a monetary fine, including a victim fine surcharge.
