Defendant: Traditional Air Systems Inc., Etobicoke.

Charge: Part I Provincial Offence Notice, *Ontario College of Trades and Apprenticeship Act, 2009*, sec. 4 – employing or otherwise engaging individual to engage in compulsory trade without Certificate of Qualification.

Summary: On Nov. 16, 2015, Ontario College of Trades enforcement officers attended a renovation site of a single family dwelling in Toronto. Two individuals were confirmed to be performing work of refrigeration and air conditioning systems mechanics (313A) while not having a Certificate of Qualification or being members the College.

On Nov. 17, 2015, Traditional Air Systems Inc. was issued a Part I Provincial Offence Notice (ticket) for violation under the *Ontario College of Trades and Apprenticeship Act, 2009*, sec. 4 – employing or otherwise engaging individual to engage in compulsory trade without Certificate of Qualification, and pleaded guilty on Jan. 14, 2016.
