Subject: Amendment to the Fuel Oil Code Adoption Document – Adoption of 2012 TSSA Environmental Management Protocol and 2012 TSSA Field Approval Code

The Director of Ontario Regulation 213/01 (Fuel Oil) pursuant to section 5 of Ontario Regulation 223/01 (Codes and Standards Adopted by Reference) hereby provides notice that the Fuel Oil Code Adoption Document published by the Technical Standards & Safety Authority, dated June 1, 2001, as amended, is further amended as follows:

All sections of the Fuel Oil Code Adoption Document dated June 1, 2001 are revoked and replaced with the following:

1. The CSA *Ontario Installation Code for Oil-burning Equipment (Based on CSA B139, with Ontario Amendments) 1st edition / 2006*, published by the Canadian Standards Association, is adopted with the following amendment:
 - a) section 15 is revoked.
2. TSSA-FA-2012, the *TSSA Field Approval Code* (August, 2012), is adopted.
3. The TSSA *Environmental Management Protocol for Fuel Handling Sites in Ontario* (August, 2012) is adopted.
4. This amendment is effective on December 1, 2012.

Any person involved in an activity, process or procedure to which this document applies shall comply with this document.
