Defendant: Dexter Casongsong, 19, of Newmarket.

Charge: Part I Provincial Offences Act summons for an offence under *the Ontario College of Trades and Apprenticeship Act, 2009*, sec. 2 – individual engaging in compulsory trade without a Certificate of Qualification.

Summary: On Oct. 23, 2015, Ontario College of Trades enforcement officers followed up on a unit installation at a Wallaceburg residence. Two individuals were confirmed to be performing work of refrigeration and air conditioning systems mechanics (313A) while not having a Certificate of Qualification or being members of the College.

On Apr. 5, 2016, Casongsong pleaded guilty to the charge under sec. 2 of the *Ontario College of Trades and Apprenticeship Act, 2009*; suspended sentence.
