Defendant: Traditional Air Systems Inc. – Etobicoke

Charge: Part I Provincial Offences Act summons for an offence under the Ontario College of Trades and Apprenticeship Act, 2009, sec. 4 – employing or otherwise engaging individual to engage in compulsory trade without a Certificate of Qualification.

Summary: On Nov. 16, 2015, Ontario College of Trades enforcement officers attended a renovation site of a single family dwelling located in Toronto. Two individuals were confirmed to be performing work of refrigeration and air conditioning systems mechanics (313A) while not having a Certificate of Qualification or being members of the College.

On Jan. 14, 2016, Traditional Air Systems Inc. pleaded guilty to the charge under sec. 2 of the Ontario College of Trades and Apprenticeship Act, 2009.
