

# October 17, 2016 – Simon BENINATO o/a RENOWOW!

**Defendant: Simon BENINATO o/a RENOWOW!**

**Charge:** Part I *Provincial Offences Act* notice for an offence under the *Ontario College of Trades and Apprenticeship Act, 2009*, sec. 4 – employing or otherwise engaging individual to engage in compulsory trade without a Certificate of Qualification.

**Summary:** On August 18, 2015 Ontario College of Trades enforcement officers received complaint from a Toronto homeowner alleging that individual's performed compulsory work in their home without proper qualifications from April 13, 2015 – April 24, 2015. The enforcement officers determined that Simon BENINATO o/a RENOWOW! employed one (1) individual who performed the work of a sheet metal worker (308A) without proper qualifications, in particular, the individual did not hold Certificates of Qualification and was not an apprentice in the trade working pursuant to a registered training agreement.

On October 17, 2016 Simon BENINATO o/a RENOWOW! was convicted of the charge and the court imposed a monetary fine, including a victim fine surcharge.
