## **Defendant: Shupeng Li**

**Charge:** Part III *Provincial Offences Act* summons for an offence under the *Ontario College of Trades and Apprenticeship Act, 2009*, sec. 86 (6) (b) – person knowingly acquires or attempts to acquire any information respecting the contents of the examination if the person is an applicant for a Certificate of Qualification or statement of membership.

**Summary:** On Jan. 15, 2016, Ontario College of Trades enforcement officers commenced an investigation into an exam misconduct incident that took place at the Ministry of Training, Colleges and Universities Toronto office, as it was formerly known.

The enforcement officers determined that one individual attempted to record exam questions by using a device embedded in his wrist watch while challenging the exam.

On September 15, 2016, Li was convicted of the charge and the court imposed a monetary fine, including a victim fine surcharge.
